PRIORITIES	How Parents Can Help
PRIORITY 1: To raise attendance of vulnerable groups in particular Pupil Premium and SEND so that it is in line or better than national average. PRIORITY 2: For fluency skills in Arithmetic to be developed through QFT and purposeful maths meetings to improve outcomes for pupils so that 75% of pupils are working at the expected standard	- Send your child to school every day - DO NOT book term time holidays - Book appointments at weekends, in the evening or in holidays where possible - Limit the length of absence to the shortest time possible e.g. send your child back on a Friday if they are well enough rather than waiting until Monday - Celebrate good attendance with your child at home - Access Numbots or Times Tables Rock Stars at home - Practise number skills at home - Use information shared at parents evening to work on specific areas - Send your child to school every day so gaps do not develop
PRIORITY 3: To accelerate progress for year 3 and 4 to improve outcomes with at least 70% of children working at the expected standard in reading, writing and maths	 Send pupils to school everyday Practise spellings Encourage pupils to read every day Attend parents evenings Ask children what they are working on currently Access Times Tables Rock Stars regularly to build fluency
PRIORITY 4: To promote high-quality oracy in the classroom across the curriculum so that pupils use high quality vocabulary in well-structured sentences	Ask your child about their day at school and encourage them to respond in full sentences Model speaking correctly Introduce your child to new words and explain their meaning
PRIORITY 5: To raise the attainment to 72% in reading and writing for boys in KS2	- Practise their spellings at home (available on ESchools) - Use Spelling Shed at Home - Attend any school workshops - Ask about writing targets at parents evening and how you can support these - Read with your child every day or ask them about what they have read independently - Choose books that are interesting and linked to what they like

PRIORITY 6: 75% of SEND to make consistent or notable progress in reading, writing and maths as a result of effective adaptations and knowledge of pupils needs.

- Attend parents evening
- Work on IEP/ EHCP targets at home and feedback to school on how this is going
 Liaise with the SENDCo, if needed, about support and professional advice
