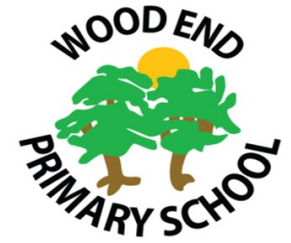


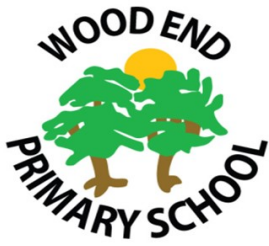
Our PE kit



At Wood End Primary School we take pride in how smart we look in our uniform. As part of our one word school rule, respect, we always wear the correct clothes to school. On a PE day we come to school ready for PE. We need to wear:

- A plain white t-shirt
- Plain black shorts or jogging bottoms
- A plain black jacket or a school jumper/cardigan
- Plain black or white trainers or pumps

If your child has earrings these need to be removed on PE days or covered with plasters at home. This is to prevent accidents during lessons.



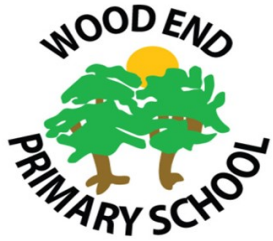
Our Uniform



Our uniform is important to our children because it shows that they belong to our school community. When a child looks smart they feel ready to learn.

Children should wear:

- A plain white polo t-shirt
- Plain black trousers or a skirt
- A red jumper with the school logo (this can be purchased through the school shop on our website)
- Plain white or black socks
- Black shoes (further guidance on the next page)
- In warmer months the children may wear black tailored shorts or a red gingham summer dress.
- If your child has their ears pierced they should only wear small silver or gold studs
- Long hair should be tied back with a plain black or red hairband.



Acceptable Footwear Guidance

Examples of shoe styles that are acceptable.

These plain smart black shoes are of a suitable design that can be polished and offer protection against weather and spillages.

Examples of styles that are unacceptable and must not be worn.

These styles offer little protection, are often not plain black in colour, are canvas or trainer style and are not suitable as part of the Wood End school uniform.
