# **Uniform**

As the end of the year approaches, your thoughts will no doubt be turning to getting uniform for the next school year. I just wanted to issue some reminders before you spend money on incorrect uniform.

Children are expected to wear:

- a jumper with the school logo on it. These are available to purchase through our ParentPay shop and can then be collected from the school office. A link to the shop is on the home page of the school website
- a white polo shirt with three buttons at the neck, not a formal school shirt
- BLACK trousers, skirts, pinafore dresses (not grey)
- white or black socks
- black school shoes (not trainers or boots)

If you are in receipt of free school meals (not just the KS1 universal entitlement), you are entitled to a free jumper subsidised by school. Please contact the office.

It is important that pupils wear the correct uniform so they feel part of our school and it is part of our respect agenda.

#### **PE Kit**

For PE lessons, we also have a 'uniform' for the children to wear. All children are expected to wear:

- white plain t-shirt with a round neck
- black shorts (indoors)
- black tracksuit bottoms/ leggings (outdoor)
- black pumps/ trainers

Please ensure PE kit is in school on the correct days for PE and that all uniform and PE kit is labelled with your child's name so we can return any items we find in school. We are all too aware of the cost of uniform for families so by labelling their clothes you give us the best chance of finding and returning lost property.

Thank you for your support in this, our children look very smart. It is important that we maintain our high standards of uniform to reflect our pride in our school.


